 Accessibility means that hardware, software, websites, mobile applications and the Internet (Web) of Things are *Perceivable*, *Operable*, *Understandable* and *Robust* for all people, whatever their hardware, software, language, location or abilities.

• Goal: an inclusive society where people with disabilities can fully and equally participate.

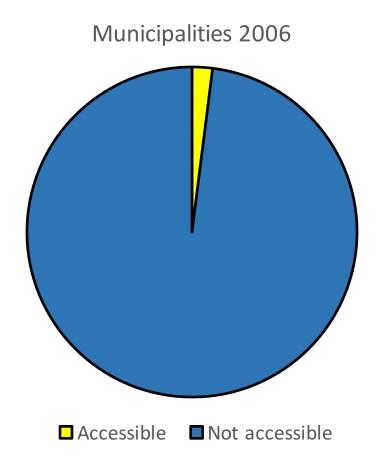

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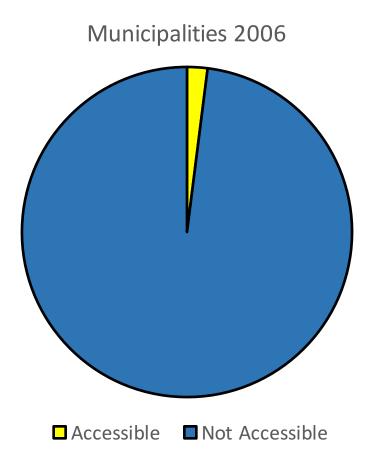

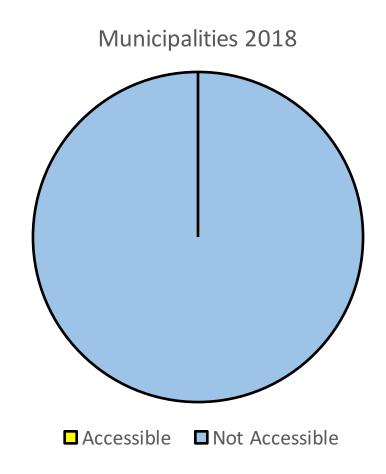
• Many municipalities have freely embraced accessibility and have started implementation (website)

### We measured them in 2006

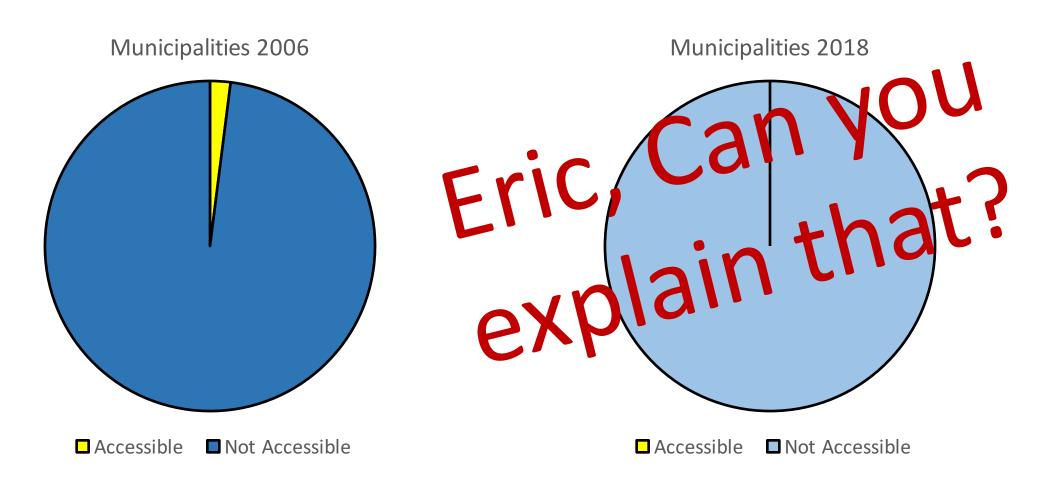

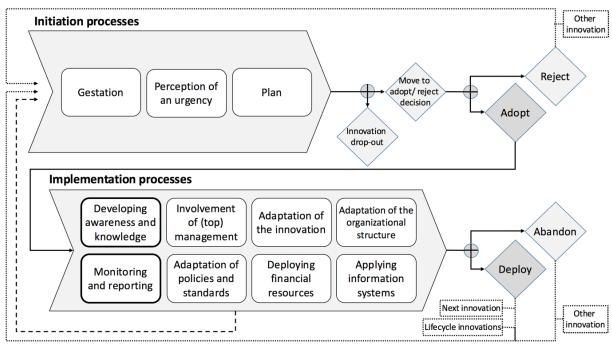

## Research question

 Result: Explorative 'initiation and implementation model for web accessibility innovations'.



#### Conclusion

- We are looking at it the wrong way
- Compliance is not enough
  - Compliance: has the law been applied, have the standards been applied?
  - Compliance misses: process and measures
- It is not a technical problem but rather an organizational problem
- An individual cannot succeed if the organization does not support it
- Municipalities are partly dependant on external parties
- Errors (with the technical standards) are mostly easy to fix (low hanging fruit)

### So what did we learn?

• Extend focus from technical implementation to organizational process
